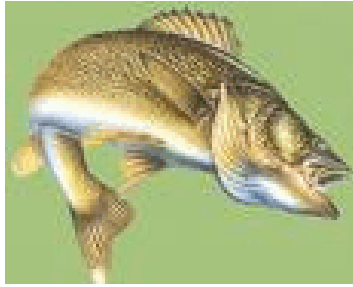

SECOND ANNUAL LOCAL 58 BENEVOLENT FUND DETROIT RIVER WALLEYE TOURNAMENT TOURNAMENT RULES

1. Maximum of 4 contestants per boat.
2. Tournament waters are the Detroit River only (Michigan waters).
 - A. Boundaries are the north end of Peche Island to south end of Celeron Island.
3. Participants can launch at any site on the river but must weigh in at the designated weigh-in site (Del-Ray Launch) by the deadline of 3:30pm or will be disqualified.
 - A. Fishing times are 7:30am to 3:00pm. Weigh-In 3:00pm to 3:30pm.
4. Contestants are required to abide by all U.S. Coastguard and DNR rules/regulations.
5. Teams will be allowed to weigh a total of 5 Walleye/Sauger/Saugeye per team. This is a harvest tournament. Fish do not need to be alive to weigh-in.
 - A. Fish must be a minimum of 15" in length.
 - B. No fish will be weighed that has sunken eyes or gills that won't bleed.
6. Prizes will be awarded as follows: (50% of Entry Fees to Benevolent Fund and 50% to be awarded in Prizes)
 - 1st Place - 50% of Prize Money
 - 2nd Place - 25% of Prize Money
 - 3rd Place - 15% of Prize Money
 - 4th Place - 10% of Prize Money
 - Big Fish Contest - 100% of Big Fish entry money to be awarded to Big Fish Winner.
7. In the event of a tie in weight, the teams will split 1st and 2nd place prize money equally. The same rule applies to all ties except the Big Fish contest in which ties will be determined by length.
8. No alcoholic beverages or illegal substances may be consumed or in the possession of any contestant during tournament hours.
9. All protests must be filed with the Tournament Directors by the close of scales. A protest fee of \$50 will be required for a protest to be considered. If the protest is upheld, then the fee will be returned to the protester. If the protest is not upheld, the money will be awarded to the Local 58 Benevolent Fund.
10. All questions, judgements or problems during a tournament will be referred to the Tournament Directors. Tournament Directors have sole authority and jurisdiction in determining the application of all rules and subsequent penalties.
