Eligibility Requirements:

Applicants must be IBEW Local 58 current dues paying members (retirees included) or related non-members, as further delineated. Such non-members are limited to sons, daughters, immediate nieces/nephew, and following the principle of "In Loco Parentis", adolescents may apply as long as their current situation is satisfactorily substantiated to the IBEW 58 Women's Committee by the member in good standing, if requested. Each situation will be evaluated on a case by case basis. Applicants must 1) provide proof of a "C/2.0" or better from last/current school enrolled, 2) submit a letter of acceptance and approval for enrollment into a post-secondary school certified by the Department of Education in the state of Michigan and accredited by the local accrediting association, 3) submit a 500-1000 typewritten word essay that includes their decision on their chosen field of study, how unions have impacted their life and explain the importance of giving back to your community, 4) submit a letter of community service involvement, 5) submit a letter of recommendation as to why you should receive the scholarship.

Awards

Scholarship awards will be granted based on the amount of money raised each year and not automatically renewed. Applications will be reviewed and winners will be selected by the IBEW Local 58 Women's Committee designees prior to the Annual ARC Awards & Scholarship Dinner. Applicants **may** be subject to a personal interview with a representative of IBEW Local 58 Women's Committee. Monies will be sent directly to the school **no later than** August preceding school year.

Application Submittal
